

MetroHartford Brownfields Assessment Program Notification of Proposed Work Plan

The Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) has been awarded funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to continue the environmental assessment of potential brownfield sites that may contain hazardous substances or petroleum products. The program will fund assessments in the 35-municipality greater Hartford region at sites which are identified during the term of the project.
