

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF CRCOG
FY-08 HOMELAND SECURITY SPENDING PLAN TO THE
CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
AND HOMELAND SECURITY**

WHEREAS, FY 08 Homeland Security Grant Guidance was issued by the Connecticut Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEMHS) with an emphasis once again on regional collaboration; and

WHEREAS, The State has distributed Memorandums of Understanding to each community designating various regional planning organizations to administer funds; and

WHEREAS, our region is made up of the 29 CRCOG municipalities and an additional 12 municipalities who make up the membership of the Capitol Region Emergency Planning Committee which was also designated as the Regional Emergency Planning Team per DEMHS guidelines; and

WHEREAS, this proposed funding plan contains 14 priority projects in the areas of equipment, training, exercise, communication, planning and management, and administration and conforms to all State and Federal guidelines; and

WHEREAS, our proposed funding plan is based primarily upon sustaining and enhancing current homeland security initiatives, but also includes three new projects: a photo license project for the CAPTAIN system in conjunction with the CT DMV, and funds for both the Regional Police Training Facility and replacement of personal protective equipment; and

WHEREAS, this plan has been approved by both the Regional Emergency Planning Team and the Capitol Region Chiefs of Police Association.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the CRCOG Policy Board authorize the CRCOG Executive Director to submit the funding plan to the State of Connecticut Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security so that CRCOG may administer and receive funds for the priority projects on behalf of its members.
