

**PUBLIC SAFETY COUNCIL**

❖ **Meeting Called to Order at 12:03 p.m.** by Chief Jim Strillacci. He stated that Chairman Thomas was not present due to the death of Trooper Hall and the group observed a moment of silence in his memory.

❖ **Public Forum**

❖ **CAPTAIN Technical Review Committee**

Jim Donnelly stated that there will be e-citation training sessions set up shortly and that participating communities will need to document a 20% match, either cash or in-kind. He urged departments to send a letter to Senator Lieberman in regard to the D block. Cheryl Assis to distribute a draft letter. He stated that the HEARTBEAT CAD system is running in Bridgeport with New Britain implementation scheduled for March. KTI, the HEARTBEAT vendor is now also working on the CT-CHIEF RMS system.

Cheryl Assis introduced Peter Sullivan who will be working on the CAPTAIN Fire project and is to begin scheduling site visits with communities.

❖ **Capitol Region Emergency Planning Committee (CREPC)**

Dan Vindigni stated that the full-scale exercise (Political Storm) was held in May at the Greater Hartford Public Safety Academy in Enfield. In June the group had a presentation by Middletown Emergency Manager George Dunn regarding the Kleen Energy explosion. The next meeting will focus on the CREPC Road Ahead document highlighting focus areas for the next ten years.

❖ **New Business**

- Director William Youell provided an update from the Office of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications.
- Manchester Police Chief Marc Montminy gave a debriefing on the Hartford Distributors Incident. He also recognized Chiefs Sirois and Kenny for their assistance and introduced new Manchester Captain Jim Neiswanger.
