

Textured Crosswalks

DEFINITION: A crosswalk enhanced with patterned brick or stone pavers instead of traditional painted road markings. Textured crosswalks can also be lined with lights built into the pavement which provide safety to pedestrians at dusk and dark.



BENEFITS:

- Brings prominence to crosswalks
- Contributes to the aesthetics of an area
- Helps slow traffic

CONSIDERATIONS:

- Depending on the material used, maintenance and durability can become a challenge
