### **TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT**

The Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation, denied benefits, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity, on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

CRCOG as a recipient and subrecipient of federal financial assistance will ensure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and related statutes and regulations in all CRCOG programs and activities.

Any person who believes that he or she has been subjected to discrimination or retaliation based on their race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints may be filed directly to CRCOG or to the Federal Funding agency. Complaints must be filed in writing and signed by the complainant or a representative and should include the complainant's name, address, and telephone number or other means by which the complainant can be contacted. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act.

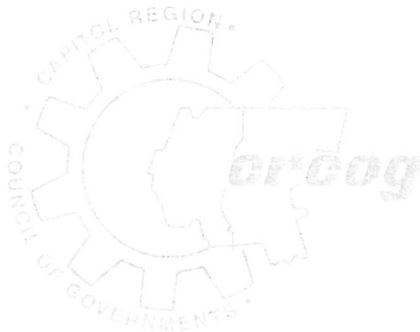

## RESOLUTION ON TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964



**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the CRCOG Policy Board adopts the attached Title VI Policy Statement, appoints the CRCOG Finance Director as the CRCOG Title VI Coordinator, with the full duties of the Title VI Coordinator as described in the CRCOG Title VI Complaint Process, and authorizes the CRCOG Executive Director to provide any required Title VI assurances to State and federal funding organizations.
