

**RESOLUTION OF THE CAPITOL REGION
COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL BUS
SHELTER PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, local bus service in the Capitol Region is now provided regionwide by Connecticut Transit; and

WHEREAS, the installation and maintenance of local bus shelters are now the responsibility of individual municipalities within the Capitol Region; and

WHEREAS, operating, management and cost efficiencies can be realized through a regional bus shelter program; and

WHEREAS, a program of advertising within bus shelters could finance such a regional bus shelter program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, it is the consensus of the Policy Board of the Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) that a regional bus shelter program would be beneficial to the Capitol Region; that CRCOG staff should continue to investigate with its partner agencies the details of such a regional program; and that it should develop a bus shelter advertising proposal that specifically addresses: a methodology by which individual municipalities would join or withdraw from the program; the participating municipalities' ability to consult on and control advertising content and location; and suggestions for meeting local zoning and/or municipal employee union requirements.
