

Questions and Answers re: I-84 Viaduct Study RFQ

Question raised: Is there an estimated budget for the viaduct study?

Response: Our procurement policies prevent us from disclosing project budget information. However, it is our intention that this be a small planning study completed in a short timeframe. It will identify alternatives and provide a general evaluation of those alternatives. A more detailed engineering and cost assessment of alternatives will be part of a subsequent study.

Question: Would the selected consultant for CRCOG's I-84 Viaduct Study, referred to in the RFQ as the Phase 1 study, be precluded from working on (as a prime or subconsultant) ConnDOT's subsequent Phase 2 study of the viaduct and surrounding area? Would a subconsultant working on the Phase 1 study be precluded from participating in ConnDOT's Phase 2 study?
